- Performances: Tamara gave an update on performances. There are 14 official performances with possibly an additional 3 performances. All performances and a tentative program will be finalized tonight.
 - Shola will be completing the program when the final order of performances is decided.
 - We discussed that past Banquets have had 14-17 performances.
 - Kareem said the music is not completed. He is still waiting on groups to communicate with him.
 - **The dress rehearsal will be at 5:00 pm this Friday, Nov. 13th at the PSU theater. Rehearsal will start promptly at 5:00 so all groups must be present by 4:30 p.m. All performers must be present in their outfits. If you are not there, you will be cut from the show!**
- Decorations: Salima still needs volunteers to help with decorations. The committee will be meeting Friday night to fold programs and napkins. They also need someone on Saturday to go to Wal-Mart around 4:30 to pick up the dry ice. Sheila Herr suggested making a sign to warn people who may be allergic to dry ice.
- Food: Minnie asked all those who submitted a recipe/head cooks to be at Blair-Shannon at 7:00 p.m. on Friday night and all helpers to arrive by 8:00 p.m. Please bring knives and cutting boards. All those who are helping cook and re-heat on Saturday need to be there by 2:00 p.m
- Tickets: There are 19 tickets left.
 - Members and helpers will receive their tickets on Friday night from the committee chairs. A list is being made of all members and helpers.
 - 208 student tickets were sold and 167 general admission tickets were sold for a total of \$5,268. There are 6 complementary tickets. If they are not claimed, they can be sold as well.
 - If you bought a ticket but are helping in the Banquet, you can be reimbursed at the Multicultural Resource Center and receive your discounted ticket on Friday.
