Do you qualify for Psi Chi - the National Honor Society in Psychology?

The minimum qualifications for active student membership in Psi Chi are:

1. Second-semester sophomore status.
2. Completion of nine credits of psychology courses, some of which must have been at Missouri State.
3. Declaration of a major or a minor in psychology.
4. Undergraduate students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 and also have a GPA of 3.00 in psychology courses.
5. Graduate students must have a GPA of 3.00 in all graduate courses, including psychology.
6. High standards of personal behavior.
7. Two-thirds affirmative vote of the Psi Chi members present at a regular meeting of the chapter.
8. Payment of local Psi Chi dues (\$10 one time) and national dues (\$45 one time for lifetime membership).
9. Complete the registration form for the national office and turn it in to Dr. Adena Young-Jones for verification of your qualifications. The form is available on the web at <http://www.psichi.org> or in HILL 101.
